1969 MEETING: The AIBS has changed its 1969 meeting from Washington State University to the University of Vermont. Present plans are for the Animal Behavior Society to meet with the AIBS in 1969.

LAB MANUAL PUBLISHED - The laboratory manual, sponsored by the Animal Behavior Society, through its Education Committee, with Allen W. Stokes as Editor, is titled ANIMAL BEHAVIOR IN LABORATORY AND FIELD, and has been published by W. H. Freeman and Company, 660 Market Street, San Francisco, California 94104, and 7 Cromwell Road, London S. W. 7, England. It contains 42 separate exercises by members of the ABS and is available either as a bound manual or as separate loose-leaf exercises. This laboratory manual is the first of its kind at the college and university level.

SYMPOSIUM - THE PHYSIOLOGY OF FIGHTING AND DEFEAT, will be held as a part of the Animal Behavior Society Program at the AAAS meetings, Dallas, Texas in December 1968. Dr. J. P. Scott is the organizer of this symposium.

SYMPOSIUM - THE USE OF SPACE IN ANIMALS AND MAN: This International Symposium, sponsored by the AAAS and the ABS, and organized by Dr. A. H. Esser, will be a part of the program of the 1968 meetings at Dallas, Texas in December.

BOTH SIDES OF THE RAILING: A symposium on animal behavior, designed as a recognition of the great dependence upon zoo resource, was presented at SAN FRANCISCO STATE COLLEGE May 9-11, 1968. This symposium was sponsored by the newly created SAN FRANCISCO INSTITUTE OF ANIMAL BEHAVIOR. This Institute represents a consolidation of the resources of the California Academy of Sciences, the San Francisco Zoological Society and the San Francisco State College Division of Biology.

A SYMPOSIUM on the Development of Behavior was held April 12-13, 1968 at West Virginia University in honor of the late Karl S. Lashley who received his baccalaureate degree at West Virginia University in 1910.

MICHIGAN STATE UNIVERSITY: Dr. Lynwood Clemens has joined the staff of Michigan State University as an Assistant Professor of Zoology. His primary association will be with the Animal Behavior Program and its endocrinological aspects.
